

# Violations Occurring On or After February 1, 2022

Notice to Employers: **Maximum Civil Penalties for Violations** of Occupational Safety and Health Standards will change on Feb. 1, 2022.

This part shall be used to assess penalties for violations occurring on or after February 1, 2022 where penalties are being assessed before February 1, 2022:

## Statutory Maximum and Minimum Penalties

Set by AS 18.60.091, AS 18.60.095, 8 AAC 61.140

<b>Willful</b>	<b>\$145,027</b>	<b>\$10,360</b>

<b>Serious</b>	<b>\$14,502</b>	<b>N/A*</b>
<b>Other than serious</b>	<b>\$14,502</b>	<b>N/A</b>
<b>Failure to abate</b>	<b>\$14,502</b> per day unabated beyond the abatement date**	<b>N/A</b>
<b>Post Requirements</b>	<b>\$14,502</b>	<b>N/A</b>

\* Civil penalty amounts will be revised annually by the department according to changes in the U.S. Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U). This revision will occur no later than February 1.

\*\* Generally limited to 30 days maximum
